Dear 2025 Scholarship Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Compton High School Alumni Association (CHSAA) Scholarship Program. We are thrilled to be able to present this opportunity to you, as this is one way of giving back to our beloved alma mater, Compton High School!

Guidelines for submitting your application are detailed below and the pages that follow. Your completed application package must be mailed or hand-delivered to the Compton High College Counselor <u>no later</u> than Thursday, May 1, 2025.

Eligible applicants must meet the following requirements to apply:

- 1. Be a Compton High School senior.
- 2. Have at least a 2.5 grade point average.
- 3. Be accepted to an accredited college or university.
- 4. Must not be a relative of a current CHSAA board member.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Each applicant must submit the following documents to be considered:

- 1. A 2025 CHSAA Scholarship Application Form.
- 2. Two (2) original letters of recommendation. Photocopies will not be accepted no exceptions.
 - One letter <u>must</u> be from one of the following: teacher, school department chairperson, school counselor, or school administrator; <u>and</u>
 - One letter <u>must</u> be from one of the following: religious or civic leader, employer, or volunteer supervisor.
- 3. A <u>sealed</u> current copy of official school transcript (*stamped with the school's seal*) showing at least a **2.5 grade point average** (GPA) on a four-point scale. **Unsealed and/or photocopied school transcripts will not be accepted.**
- 4. A letter of acceptance to an accredited college or university (if available).
- 5. One typed response to the essay question included in this application packet.
- 6. All documents must be submitted together -- no separate submittals.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD GUIDELINES

- Funds will not be distributed to the awardee until (1) the awardee provides the letter from the school stating that the awardee has been *officially* (not "conditionally") accepted into the school, and (2) receipt of the awardee's official class schedule.
- Scholarship awards must be applied to the tuition costs and/or required class materials at the approved institution.
- The recipient is expected to continue his/her studies at the approved institution of higher education for the full academic year.

Judging

Judging will occur in two stages: <u>Stage 1: Evaluation of the completed application</u>. The applicants that do not follow the submission guidelines will be eliminated. The compliant applicants who pass Stage 1 will proceed to Stage 2. <u>Stage 2: The interview</u>. The applicant will be judged on overall presentation (response to the questions and appearance). The applicants will be notified when the date and location have been determined. The winner(s) will be selected and notified prior to the school's awards assembly.

- Selection of the recipients will be made by the CHSAA Scholarship Committee. Applicants will be evaluated on the following:
 - 1. Overall appearance of application submittal and essay
 - 2. Grade Point Average
 - 3. Response to essay question
 - 4. Extra-curricular activities
 - 5. Financial Need
 - 6. Interview

Points to Remember

- This is a very competitive process. The package you turn in is a representation of you. Therefore, all documents should be neat and professional.
- Incomplete application packages (those applications not adhering to the Scholarship Submittal Guidelines) *will not* be considered; no exceptions.
- Altering or modifying the Scholarship application will result in automatic disqualification.

Completed application packages must be postmarked or submitted <u>no later than Thursday</u>, <u>May 1, 2025</u> to be considered.
